





MEMORANDUM FOR DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF, G-3/5/7

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for DOD Executive Agent Responsibilities, Functions and Authorities for the Joint Center for International Security Force Assistance (JCISFA)

1. Reference Memorandum, Sec Def, 04 April 2006, subject: Joint Center for International Security Force Assistance (JCISFA) Charter, with Attachments.
2. Pursuant to Department of Defense Directive 5101.1 (DoD Executive Agent), paragraph 4.3, I hereby delegate to the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-3/5/7 authority to act on my behalf for any and all DoD Executive Agent responsibilities, functions and authorities assigned to me by the Secretary of Defense in the referenced memorandum and its attachments.
3. Unless expressly prohibited or restricted by law, directive, regulation, or policy, you may re-delegate this authority within your organization, but to an official no lower than a general officer or member of the Senior Executive Service. Should you elect to re-delegate this authority, you may further restrict or condition your delegate's exercise of the same. A re-delegation of authority shall not be effective unless it is in writing, signed by you and has been determined not to be legally objectionable upon review by the Office of the Army General Counsel. No re-delegation shall take effect until a record copy of the same has been provided to the Office of the Administrative Assistant, my focal point for DoD Executive Agent matters, for archiving. I will hold you responsible for any and all actions taken pursuant to this delegation or any re-delegation thereof.
4. This delegation is effective immediately and will remain in effect until suspended, revoked or superseded.
